2020 Joint Research Project among NatComs for UNESCO in East and Southeast Asia

- 10 NatComs participated in the project, from Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Mongolia, Myanmar, the Philippines, the Republic of Korea, Thailand, Timor-Leste and Vietnam.
- The Joint Research Report explores individual histories, common goals and future priorities of the participating NatComs.
- A second phase of the joint project will be launched this year based on the suggestions made by each NatCom.

Bridge Programme

- KNCU has been implementing this Programme since 2010 to contribute to achieving SDG 4 by promoting accessibility to education for the underprivileged in Africa and Asia.
- KNCU newly launched the second phase of the Programme with Bhutan, Laos, and Timor-Leste in 2020, and with Malawi in 2021.
- As with the first phase, the second phase of the Programme emphasizes cooperation and partnership among NatComs.
